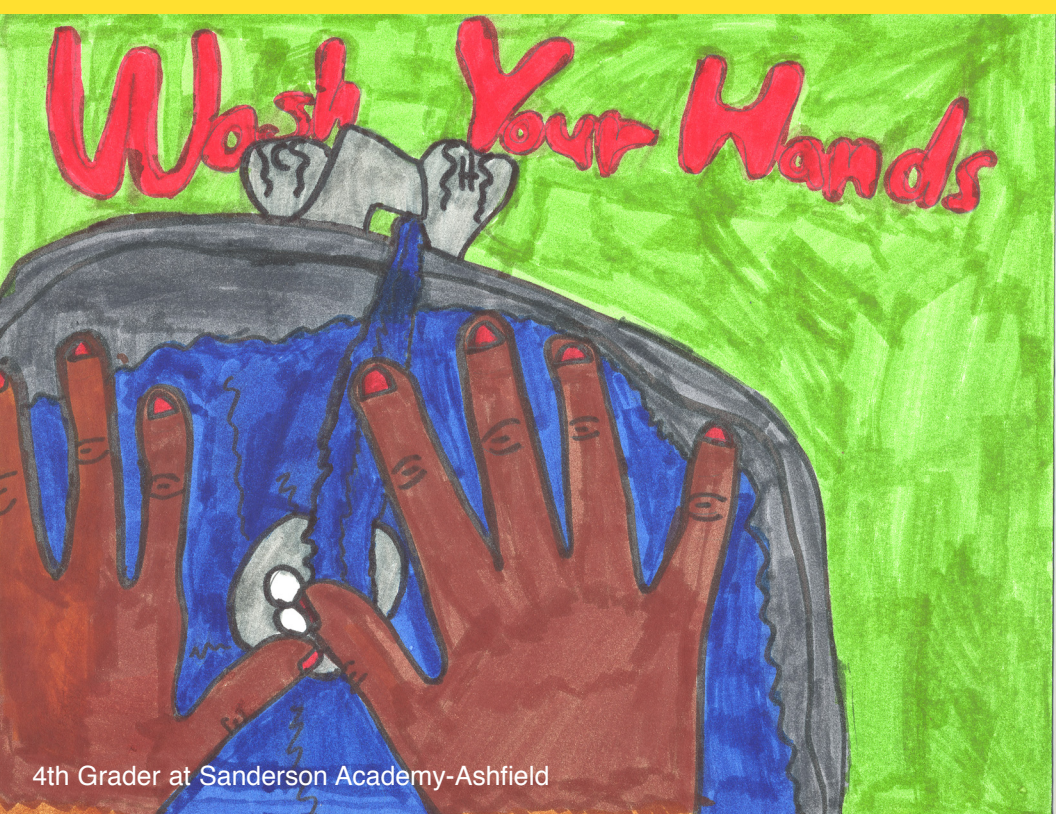


SINGING AT THE SINK
